The Department of Computer Science at JMU invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the Assistant Professor or Associate Professor level to begin August 2010. The Department is interested in extending or expanding its activities in a variety of areas, but preference will be given to applicants with expertise in multimedia, computer gaming, web systems, cloud computing, cyber-forensics or information security. Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated excellence in teaching and research, with the potential to develop an active, undergraduate-oriented research program. We welcome applicants with an interest in teaching online. A Ph.D. in Computer Science or related field at the time of employment is preferred.
