

Final Project Presentation Format

- Presentations will be in Levine 307 on Wednesday April 28 at 1:30pm
- Submit your presentations to blackboard by **11am (NO LATER!!!)** on Wednesday April 28.
- Do not embed your movies into powerpoint - most of the time they do not play. Instead add links to your movies to the slides.
- Your presentation should last **no more than 10 min.** You will also have **2 minutes for questions** from the class. We have 12 groups, so if everything goes on time, we should be done within 2 hours and 24min.
- We will have to enforce the timing, so please practice beforehand - we do not want to cut you!
- Your presentation **must** include the following information, not necessarily in this order (you should also include additional context as you feel appropriate):
 - (1) Description of the problem you are solving.
 - (2) Implementation details:
 - List papers (if any) that you used for your implementation.
 - List 3 stages exactly as in the proposal.
 - Describe what you have done at each stage.
 - **Tell us how much you have finished for each stage.**
 - Tell us what you plan to finish during the last week (most of the work, if not all, should be done by the presentation time on April 28).
 - For each stage state clearly which parts of the project you have implemented yourself and for which you have used existing software.
 - (3) **Cool movies! Show as many results as possible. This is an important part and you should spend enough time to get cool movies!** Please also feel free to include movies at any place in your presentation to illustrate a point.
- (Last Slide) State what new things you **learned** from this project. Any conclusions you made.

Final Report and Submission (due on Friday May 7 at midnight):

- Submit to blackboard (presentation slides, final report, final movies and your code)
- Report should be about 4 to 6 pages in length
- It should describe all the material above but in more details. You can also include extra information specific to your project.
- For groups of two, include a section where you describe how you divided the job between the members of the group. Please do not just state that you have done everything together.
- Please include images from your final results.
