

### **Final Presentation Format:**

- Presentations will be in Levine 307, Thursday May 7 at 2pm
- The room is available for setup from 1:30pm
- You can use computer in Levine 307, bring your own laptop/computer or use my laptop
- Please test your computer before presentation starts and have a backup of your presentation somewhere just in case. Make sure all the movies play fine.
- Also, submit your full presentations to blackboard (so that we have a copy for grading)
- 15 groups:
  - 1 person group → 5min pres + 3min for questions (7)
  - 2 people group → 7min pres + 5min for questions (4)
  - 3 people group → 10min pres + 5min for questions (4)
- We will have to enforce the timing, so please practice beforehand
- Your presentation **must** include the following slides, not necessarily in this order (you should also include additional slides as you feel appropriate):
  - Slide1:** Description of the problem you are solving
  - Slide2:** Description of the approach you took to solve the problem (brief description, you will not have time to describe all the details, they will go into report)
    - State all libraries or existing software that you used
    - State clearly which part of the project you will implement yourself
    - List papers (if any) that you used for your implementation
  - Slide3:** List 3 stages exactly as in the proposal and tell us how much you finished for each stage
  - Slide4:** **Cool movies! Show as many results as possible. This is the most important slide and the one on which you should spend more time!** Please also feel free to include movies at any place in your presentation to illustrate a point.
  - Last Slide:** State what new things you **learned** from this project. Any conclusions you made.

### **Proposal Report and Slides (due on Friday May 8 at midnight):**

- Submit to blackboard (both presentation slides and final report)
- Report should be about 3 to 4 pages in length
- It should describe all the material above but in more details. You can also include extra information specific for your project.
- For groups of two or more, include a section where you describe how you divided the job between members of the group. Please do not just state that you have done everything together.
- Please include images from your final results.
