

Disguised Faces Database

Print & Electronic Publication Consent Form

1 Voluntary

Signing this consent form is **entirely voluntary**, and your compensation and participation in the project will not be jeopardized if you do not sign it.

There is no benefit to you in releasing these images, and your alternative is to not allow publication of your images (by simply not signing this form).

2 Publication

By signing this form, you are consenting to the publication of photos and images taken of you under the conditions described below. This consent replaces and overrides the limitations on publication of photos and images taken of you that is described in section 7 of the “Disguised Faces Database Consent Form” that you signed prior to your participation in this research study.

Your signature on this form allows photos and images of you to be published by researchers who have access to the database of images being collected for the Disguised Faces Database. Publication may occur in print or electronic form (to include publication on the Internet) for conference papers and proceedings, journal publications, academic papers, thesis and dissertation work, and related publications.

This consent does **not** include consent to have your name or any other identifying information published, either alone or in conjunction with the photos or images. The demographic data you provided, which will be made available to other researchers, will not be published in any way that could be traced to you as an individual. This demographic data includes data regarding your race, gender, birth year/approximate age, and specific ethnicity.

Photos and images will only be used for the purposes and under the conditions described above. Any other use would require your specific written permission.

It will not be possible for you to inspect and/or approve documents or electronic media containing your photo or images prior to publication.

3 Risks

By signing this form, it is very likely that some of your photos will be published, and that those photos may be disguised or undisguised. In either case, it is possible that someone may recognize you, and may be able to put your name to your face.

In this scenario, all that this would tell someone is that you participated in this study. Since your demographic data is not published in any way that could be linked to you as an individual, that would not be available to anyone who recognized you.

Even if your demographic information was also inadvertently disclosed, the information (gender, race, and approximate age) is already clear from the photographs in most cases. Any unauthorized person who came into possession of the data would only be able to verify this information. They would not know your name or any other identifying information, unless they were already familiar with you.
