



Pre-Trial Risk Assessment






Exclusions

If any of the following conditions are true, the person is automatically not recommended for release

Booking charges contain one of the following

- Murder
- Voluntary Manslaughter
- Aggravated Mayhem
- Felony Sexual Assault
- Robbery
- Carjacking
- Felony Domestic Violence
- Felony Stalking
- Violation of Domestic Violence Protective Order
- Escape

Booking charges contain a violent charge and the Violence Flag is 1.

Example violent charges:

- Resisting a police officer causing death/serious injury
- Kidnapping
- False imprisonment
- Assault on a peace officer of a school district
- Poisoning
- Arson causing great bodily injury
- Rioting
- Assault on a public official

Bump-ups

If any of the following conditions are true, the person's recommendation level is increased by one.


Booking charges contain one of the following

- Violation of other protective order
- Person-to-person sex crime
- Arson
- Involved the <u>Use</u> of a weapon, etc.
- Felony inflicting Great Bodily Injury
- Misdemeanor Domestic Violence
- Misdemeanor Stalking


Booking charges do NOT contain a violent charge and the Violence Flag is 1.



Data

Data from PSA pilot run

- ~2000 cases processed during pilot study
 All charges for anyone who touched the
- Individual name/unique id
- Arrest date
- Booking Charges

Court Records

- All charges for anyone who touched the criminal justice system during the period under study (about 70,000 charges):
- Individual name/unique id
- Arrest date
- Court number*
- Outcome for every charge (i.e. guilty or not)

Results

Charges	exclusions	bump-ups	nvca	rec
Conviction	8.7	9.1	9.3	2.5
Booking	29.4	23.7	20.2	3
Difference	20.7 *	14.6 *	10.8 *	0.5 *

Table 1: Percent of cases with exclusions, bump-ups, nvca flags, and the average recommendation by input charges.

exclusions	bump-ups	nvca	rec
20.9	17.0	10.9	27.4

Table 2: Percent of cases for which each PSA component was higher under the booking charges than under the conviction charges.
